

Reiki – Shinpiden Master/Teacher Level III



For those wishing to pursue a professional career as a Practitioner and / or Teacher.

Reiki Okuden Level II – pre-requisite required.

REIKI is an energy healing modality that originated in Japan.

The word Reiki means:

Rei – Universal

Ki – life force energy

Shinpiden is the Japanese word for ‘mystery teachings’.

Reiki Shinpiden Master Teacher Level II is for those who wish to develop a deeper understanding of the power of Reiki and move up to the level of being able to impart this wonderful knowledge to others.

Shinpiden is the Japanese word meaning ‘mystery teachings’. It is aimed at Level II practitioners or established Reiki Masters who wish to continue their personal journey, by building on the skills taught at Okuden level.

In Shinpiden level you will continue to learn Japanese meditations and techniques to further enhance your skills in Reiki. You will learn how to conduct attunement and reiju (energy blessings) so that you can continue your journey in Reiki and initiating others who show enthusiasm and interest in learning Reiki.

Self-empowerment is attained in Shinpiden through a strong energetic connection to the source of Reiki. It is also the result of the confidence you will feel as a result of your thorough knowledge of Reiki – how it works, the Japanese symbols and mantras and their connection to Japanese philosophies.

One of the major focuses of this course is to tap into the sense that you are, and always were, a great, bright light of energy which is achieved by working with the fourth symbol and mantra.

- Duration - 2 day weekend (6.5 hours per day)
